

FOR THE ROOM

- Bedding: pillow, pillowcase, mattress pad, sheets and blankets; size: Twin XL
- Waste basket
- ☐ Cleaning supplies, dishwashing soap, air freshener, handheld vacuum (note all rooms are carpeted, so throw rugs are unnecessary but optional)
- □ Surge protectors; not just a power strip—make sure it has surge protection and is UL-approved
- ☐ Small fan (optional); air-conditioning provided April-Oct.
- □ Pictures, posters and other decorations that can be displayed with command strips—no tape or putty
- ☐ Laundry bag or basket, laundry detergent, fabric softener and hangers
- ☐ UL-approved electronics only, heavy duty, with a circuit breaker
- □ Flashlight
- Umbrella
- Basic first-aid kit

FOR THE DESK

- □ Desk lamp or reading lamps; permitted lamps use low heat light bulbs, compact fluorescent lighting, or LED lighting (ceiling lighting is provided in each room)
- ☐ Pens, pencils and pencil sharpener
- ☐ Lined paper and computer paper
- □ Computer and printer if desired; both are available in labs; Ethernet cord if not wireless
- Memo pad
- ☐ Rubber bands, paper clips, thumb tacks, etc.
- ☐ Tape, glue, scissors, stapler, ruler, etc.
- Alarm clock

FOR THE BATHROOM

- Towels and washcloths
- Soap and shampoo
- ☐ Shoes or flip-flops for shower
- Shower caddy
- ☐ Toothpaste, toothbrush and other personal items

WHAT NOT TO BRING

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE RESIDENCE HALLS

- ★ Pets other than fish and hermit crabs in tanks of 10 gallons or less
- ★ Halogen or lava lamps and incandescent bulbs
- Candles even if decorative or are never lit, wax or potpourri burners, incense, fireworks, lighter fluid or other incendiary devices or materials.
- ★ Tapestries, curtains, or draperies unless with a tag displaying certified as noncombustible and flame resistant (or fully treated with fire retardant spray with saved receipt and cans kept in the room

- throughout the year). Note: window shades are provided.
- Extension cords or power cubes/ strips unless multiple outlet-type with built-in fuses and/or surge protection
- Any smoking material such as tobacco, cigarettes, pipes, hookas or electronic smoking devices. Hood College is a smoke-free campus.
- ★ Refrigerators larger than 4.5 cubic feet. Only one mini refrigerator is permitted in a single, double or triple room, while guads may have

- two mini refrigerators. Fridges must be plugged directly into the wall.
- ★ Hot plates, toaster ovens, space heaters, electric blankets, cooking appliances, electronic aroma diffusers, or anything with an open heating element.
- ★ Firearms, hunting knives, ammunition, bows, arrows or any other items that are or could be classified as weapons
- * Your own desk, dresser, bed, mattress or desk chair; all College furnishings must remain in the student rooms
